

Professor Rupert Bauersachs

Professor Rupert Bauersachs is Director of the Department of Vascular Medicine at Klinikum Darmstadt GmbH, Germany, holds a Professorship at the Goethe University in Frankfurt, Germany and a Professorship for Vulnerable Individuals and Populations in Thrombosis and Hemostasis (VIP-TH) at the Center for Thrombosis and Hemostasis of the University of Mainz, Germany. He is a council member for the German Societies of Angiology and Phlebology and is active in various other societies for vascular medicine, and thrombosis and haemostasis. Professor Bauersachs completed his medical degree at the University of Munich, Germany and was a Postdoctoral Fellow in the Department of Pharmacology at the University of Munich. Subsequently, he was a Research Fellow of the American Heart Association (AHA) at the Department of Physiology, University of Southern California (USC), USA, and completed his residency in internal medicine at München-Bogenhausen Hospital and at the Universities of Mainz and Frankfurt, Germany. He is certified for internal medicine, vascular medicine, haemostaseology, diabetology, phlebology and aviation medicine.

Dr Bauersachs' main research interests include peripheral artery disease, venous thromboembolism, microcirculation, antithrombotic agents, thrombophilia and women's issues in thrombosis. He has authored more than 100 original research papers and been awarded several prizes for his scientific work.
